clinic hours

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday

Open 9am-12 noon and 2-5pm

(last walk in 4.30pm).

Wednesday open 9am-12 noon

Clinics closed weekends and public holidays.
Wednesday afternoon reserved for education, equipment checking and meetings.

Appointments are not necessary at our Clinics. Our services are free if you are registered with Medicare. If you are not registered with Medicare and you are Aboriginal, we can help you with this.

You will be seen in order of arrival unless there is an emergency. Home visits are available in certain situations. Clinics have an on call system for after-hours emergency care. In communities where nurses are not resident, the Community Support Manager is available to liaise with health staff.

The Royal Flying Doctor Service provides retrieval services from all communities.

Reminders and Screening

NHS provides high quality care. When you come to clinic we will treat your main problem and other health issues. This includes testing for early signs of disease, giving long-term treatments and immunisation.

We encourage you to contact your clinic to follow up your tests.

You can return to any clinic or phone for assistance.
